Where are they Biting?

Lakes Entrance: Trevally are biting off the jetties. Good size Flathead have been taken around Kalimna Jetty using "squidgies". The Nyerimilang area is producing King George Whiting on pilchard.

Lake Tyers: Pagey's Report - I am getting mixed reports at the Tackle Shop with some anglers doing well and others struggling. Local fisherman, Dave "the hock" Hocking, has had some excellent flathead on plastics on the drop-off behind the sand dunes in the front lake. As well as landing some trevally, he was a very happy man. Best baits have been pilchards and prawn for those using baits. Lots of prawns have kept holiday makers happy at night, so come out and have a go. The surf has seen salmon, tailor and a few flathead being taken on bluebait and squid. A surf popper is still a good option. If you want to try something different, the flashmaster lure is doing best. Looking forward to the full moon and the gummies, as I am well stocked up on eel. So, enjoy your holidays, keep safe and "get amongst them".

Mitchell River: Estuary Perch are still biting on plastic and metal lures. Bream are biting around the mouth on prawn.

Tambo River: The Highway Bridge and mouth are good for Flathead and Bream using prawn and sandworm

Nicholson: Bream are biting around "The Cut" on prawn and whitebait.

Metung: Flathead are biting off the Boardwalk and around Nungurner on prawn and soft plastics. Some King George Whiting have been caught off the Point, on pippa.
